Nursery End of Year Target

- Engage in extended conversations about stories, learning new vocabulary.
- Use some of their print and letter knowledge in their early writing. For example: writing a pretend shopping list that starts at the top of the page; writing 'm' for mummy. Write some or all of their name.
- Write some letters accurately.
- Understand the five key concepts about print: print has meaning print can have different purposes we read English text from left to right and from top to bottom the names of the different parts of a book page sequencing.

Reception End of Year Target:

- Write recognisable letters, most of which are formed correctly.
- Spell words by identifying sounds in them and representing the sound with a letter of letters.
- Write simple phrases and sentences that can be read by others.
- Invent, adapt and recount narratives and stories with peers and their teacher;
- Sing a range of well-known nursery rhymes and songs;
- Perform songs, rhymes, poems and stories with others, and when appropriate try to move in time with music.
